

Juniper Green Community Centre Youth Club is open to children from Juniper Green and the surrounding area. To register your child please speak to Youth Workers.

The club is staffed by five Youth Workers who maybe paid or voluntary. All Youth Workers go through a recruitment and selection process.

There is no annual membership to the club, but there is an activity charge of 50p per club session.

No child will be taken out on a trip without a completed and signed parental consent form (given out in advance of the trip). Selection for a trip is based upon attendance and behaviour in the club.

If there is a waiting list for a club and your child misses three consecutive weeks without giving a reasonable explanation they will automatically be removed from the register and their place given to the next person on the waiting list.

Youth Club Information for children and parents



What you can expect as a member of Juniper Green Community Centre Youth Club:

- You can join a club that involves you in discussions on numerous topics, games, sports, music meet new friends and FUN.
- You can expect your club to have a tuck shop open when your club is open.
- You can expect Youth Workers to treat you with respect, to listen to your opinions, ideas and your worries, and if asked to give you information and advice. Where information and advice is not immediately available we will either find out more or pass you onto someone who can help you.
- As a Centre we believe that children have the right to education and information which will help them make informed life choices whether this is to do with relationships, careers, drugs or health.
- Discussion on these issues will be part of the club programme.
- You can expect equal opportunities within the Centre and members whose behaviour is unacceptable to other members, visitors or staff will be challenged and may be excluded from the club for a time.
- The opportunity to be involved in the decision making process in your club and the management of the Centre by being represented on the Management Committee.

What is expected of 'you' when you become a member of Juniper Green Community Centre Youth Club:

- We expect you to contribute ideas to make the club interesting, lively and appropriate to your age group and interests.
- We expect you to respect fellow members, youth workers and visitors to the club.
- We expect you to pay the weekly club activity fee on time.
- We expect you to challenge any behaviour by fellow club members which affects the general running of the club and causes disruption of activities being enjoyed by others.
- We expect you to replace or pay for any equipment which may be lost or damaged as a result of such unacceptable behaviour.
- We expect you to understand that youth workers are humans and - like you - have feelings and sometimes they have a bad day
- We expect you to enjoy yourself and have fun, it's your club.
